

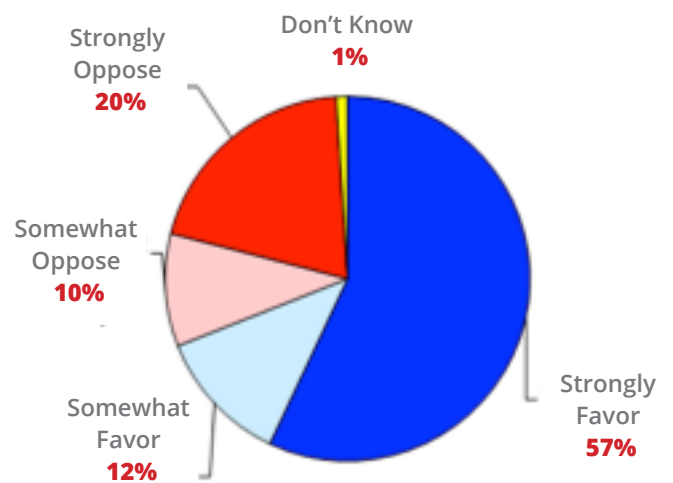


# TEXANS OVERWHELMINGLY SUPPORT RAISING THE TOBACCO AGE TO 21

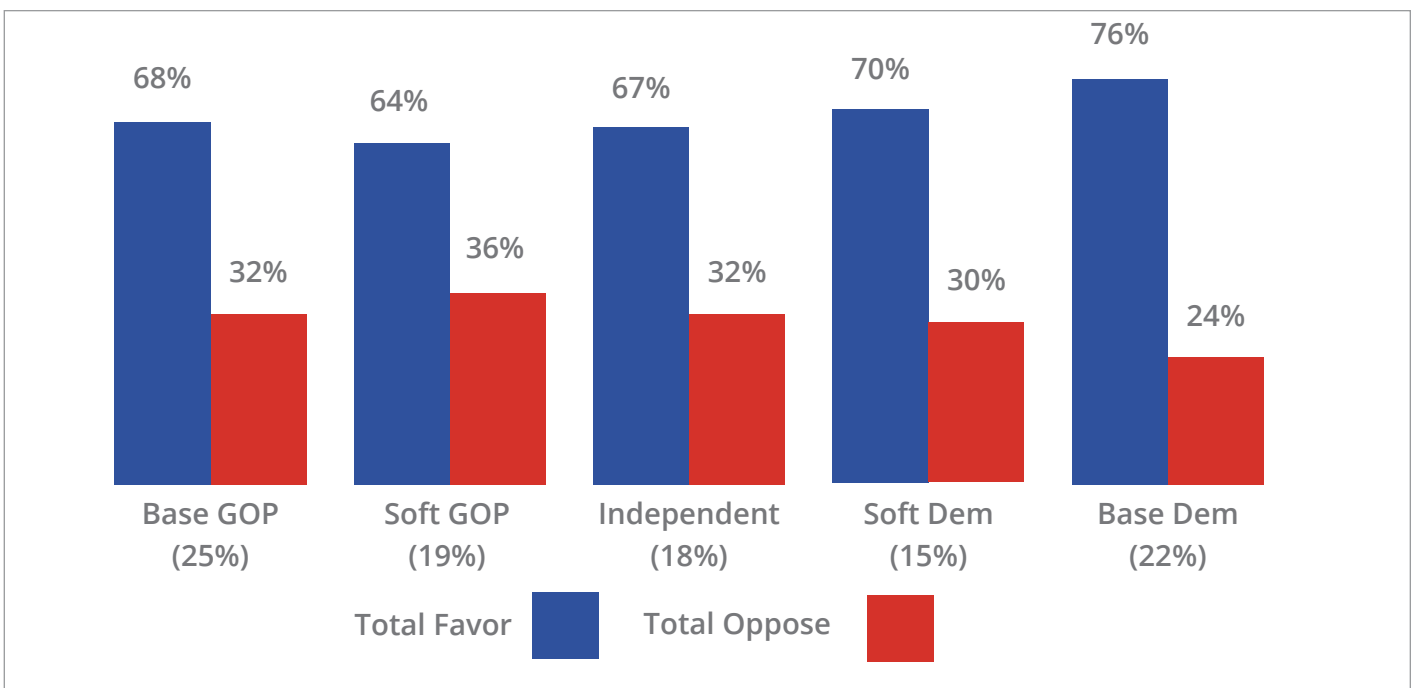
Nearly **70 percent** of voters favor a law to raise the tobacco sales age to 21.

### OVERALL

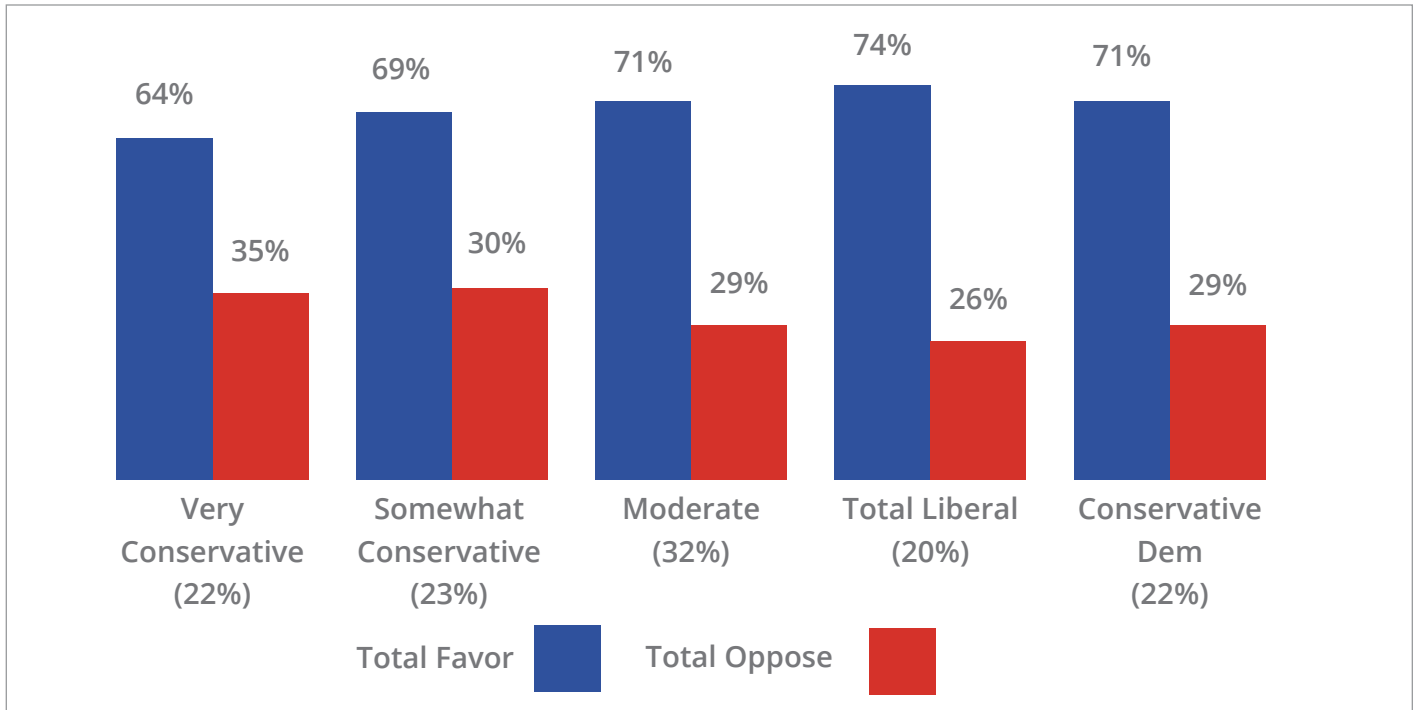
Total Favor **69%**

Houston	<b>70%</b>
San Antonio	<b>78%</b>
East-South Texas	<b>73%</b>

*This Texas statewide telephone survey was commissioned by the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network and conducted by Public Opinion Strategies, December 10-13, 2016, among 800 registered voters, including 320 cell phone respondents, and has a margin of error of +3.46%.*
